**Ride Information:** This is a fun trail ride to benefit Harmony Horseworks Horse Rescue and the co-sponsor, Special Needs Program of Evergreen Parks and Rec District. The ride is also co-sponsored by the Intermountain Branch of Jefferson County Horse Council. Riders will follow a set course collecting a poker hand from different stations in Alderfer Three Sisters and Blair Ranch Open Space Parks. **Best hand wins the pot.** Knowledge of poker is not required. Beverages and a tasty lunch from the Rib-Crib will be provided (vegetarian option with advance order). Lunch is also available to non-riders for \$10. There is a limit of 95 riders. Both a long course and a short ride are offered.

**Long course riders may start between 9:00 AM and 10:00 AM, short course between 9:00 AM and 11:00 AM and must be completed by 12:00.**

**Directions:** Travel south from Evergreen Lake on Highway 73 for 0.6 miles. Turn west (left) on Buffalo Park Road for 2.2 miles. Drive past the first (east) Open Space parking lot to the large barn next to the west parking lot just beyond the yellow house. Plenty of trailer parking next to the barn, not in the public lot.

**Liability Waivers:** I wish to ride in the Intermountain Branch - Jefferson County Horse Council poker ride as listed above. I agree to abide by the rules of the aforementioned ride. I understand that this may involve being in remote areas for extended periods of time, distant from communications, transportation, shelter, water and medical facilities; that these areas have many natural and man-made hazards, which ride management cannot anticipate, identify, modify or eliminate; that the horses can be excitable, difficult to control and unpredictable; and that accidents can happen to anyone at anytime. I agree to take full responsibility for myself and the animal I may be riding, and hereby freely assume the risk of any injury or fatality suffered by myself or the aforementioned animals as a result of my participation.

The undersigned does as guardian or for himself/herself, his/her heirs, executors, and administrators, waive and release any person or persons connected with the aforementioned ride, individually and collectively, including but not limited to: Jefferson County Horse Council and its affiliated Intermountain Branch and its officers and all individual members thereof, ride management, ride personnel, veterinarians, other riders, sponsors and all property owners over whose land the ride crosses including Jefferson County Open Space, and hold blameless for any accident, any right to assert claims for personal or property damage against any persons connected with the aforementioned ride. This ride entry form supersedes any forms previously published. The ride organizers strongly recommend wearing a protective helmet.

**WARNING:** Under Colorado Law, an equine professional is not liable for an injury to or death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities pursuant to Section 13-21-119, Colorado Revised Statutes.
